
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the purposes of financing
5 capital improvement projects for the fortieth representative
6 district, as follows

15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the

17 designated expending agencies for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
