
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,428,600 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 seventh representative district, as follows:

7 1. Haleiwa elementary school

8 Design and construction for cafeteria
9 interior painting.

10 Design \$5,000

11 Construction \$20,000

12 Total funding \$25,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

1 2. Haleiwa elementary school

2 Design and construction for painting

3 exterior of the school.

4 Design \$110,000

19 Design for drainage improvements,

21 equipment and appurtenances.

4 shall be expended by the department of education.

5 5. Sunset Beach elementary school
6 Design for additional site improvements
7 for safer access to Sunset Beach
8 neighborhood park for students,
9 faculty, and staff for school
10 activities and emergency evacuation.

11 Design \$75,000

12 Total funding \$75,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 6. Waialua high and intermediate school
16 Construction for six-foot high
17 replacement chain link fence around the
18 perimeter of the campus for safety and
19 security of students.

20 Construction \$103,600

21 Total funding \$103,600



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 7. Waialua high and intermediate school

4 Plans, design, and construction for new
5 rubber track to replace the old dirt
6 track for track and field, cross-
7 country, and physical education.

8 Plans \$1,000

9 Design \$1,000

10 Construction \$998,000

11 Total funding \$1,000,000

12 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
13 shall be expended by the department of education.

14 8. Waialua high and intermediate school

15 Plans, design, and equipment for
16 science, technology, engineering, and
17 mathematics innovation center.

18 Plans \$700,000

19 Design \$500,000

20 Equipment \$150,000

21 Total funding \$1,350,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 9. Waialua high and intermediate school
4 Plans, design, construction, and
5 equipment for one bathroom for women
6 and two bathrooms for men in the
7 vicinity of the football stadium.

10	Construction	\$298,000
11	Equipment	\$1,000
12	Total funding	\$300,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
19 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
