
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii tourism authority shall study
2 the need for a tourism information center in the state capital
3 district. The study shall include an estimate of the number of
4 tourists who visit the state capital district annually, visitor
5 services provided, and visitor needs.

6 (b) The Hawaii tourism authority shall report its findings
7 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
8 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
9 the regular session of 2021.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for a
13 study to determine whether a tourism information center is
14 needed in the state capital district.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
16 tourism authority for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099.
