
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$32,500,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fourth
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. Lower Puna boat ramp, Hawaii
8 Plans, design, construction, and
9 equipment for restoration of the boat
10 ramp in lower Puna; ground and site
11 improvements; and equipment and
12 appurtenances.

2 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
3 shall be expended by the department of land and natural
4 resources.

5 2. Pahoa public and school library, Hawaii
6 Plans, design, and construction for
7 public library independent of the
8 public school system.

9 Plans \$250,000

10 Design \$250,000

11 Construction \$500,000

12 Total funding \$1,000,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 3. Pahoa elementary school, Hawaii
16 Construction for a new cafeteria and
17 administration building; ground and
18 site improvements; and equipment and
19 appurtenances.

20 Construction \$20,000,000

21 Total funding \$20,000,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 4. Pahoa high and intermediate school,
4 Hawaii
5 Plans, design, construction, and
6 equipment for a covering for the
7 intermediate school play court; ground
8 and site improvements; and equipment
9 and appurtenances.

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the department of education.


17 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
18 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
20 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
21 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
