## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-THIRD REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$39,882,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-  
6 third representative district, as follows:

7       1.   Barbers Point elementary school  
8           Construction for Building I restrooms  
9           renovation, Building I re-roofing,  
10          resurfacing court, water line, Building  
11          H re-roofing, Building H restrooms  
12          renovation, wheel chair lift, replacing  
13          stage, and replacing airconditioning.

1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 2. Ma'ili elementary school

4 Design and construction for safety  
5 improvements, such as building security  
6 screens, perimeter fencing, ground  
7 improvements near building F and P18,  
8 ground and site improvements, and  
9 security equipment and appurtenances.

10 Design \$40,000

11 Construction \$160,000

12 Total funding \$200,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 3. Nanaikapono elementary school

16 Design and construction for expanding  
17 parking and driveways to address  
18 student safety, ground and site  
19 improvements, and equipment and  
20 appurtenances.

21 Design \$50,000

3 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 4 shall be expended by the department of education.

5 4. Nānākuli elementary school

6 Plans, design, and construction for  
 7 grounds and site improvements and  
 8 renovations, including installation of  
 9 solar panels, restroom renovations, and  
 10 other improvements due to the school's  
 11 designation as an emergency shelter.

12	Plans	\$58,500
13	Design	\$58,500
14	Construction	\$1,000,000
15	Total funding	\$1,117,000

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 17 shall be expended by the department of education.

18 5. Nānākuli high and elementary school

19 Design, construction, and equipment for  
 20 the performing arts center auditorium,



1 ground and site improvements, and  
2 equipment and appurtenances.

6	Total funding	\$35,000,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
8 shall be expended by the department of education.

9 6. Nānākuli library

10 Plans, design, and construction for  
11 grounds and site improvements,  
12 including installation of shade  
13 structures to utilize the outdoor space  
14 for library and farmer markets patrons.

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
20 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 7. Waianae coast comprehensive health  
 2 center  
 3 Construction and equipment for  
 4 renovations.

5	Construction	\$1,166,597
6	Equipment	\$333,403
7	Total funding	\$1,500,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 9 shall be expended by the department of health.

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 12 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 13 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
 14 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
