
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§291-72 Parking spaces reserved for electric vehicles;**
4 **penalties.** (a) Beginning January 1, 2013, any person who parks
5 a non-electric vehicle in a space designated and marked as
6 reserved for electric vehicles shall receive a warning.

7 (b) Beginning July 1, 2013, any person who parks a non-
8 electric vehicle in a space designated and marked as reserved
9 for electric vehicles shall be guilty of a traffic infraction
10 under chapter 291D and shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more
11 than \$100, and shall pay any costs incurred by the court related
12 to assessing the fine.

13 (c) Any citation issued under this section may be mailed
14 to the violator pursuant to section 291C-165(b).

15 (d) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, and in
16 addition to any other authority provided by law that is not
17 inconsistent with this section:

1 (1) A law enforcement officer may access the property of a
 2 private entity to enforce the provisions of this part;
 3 and

4 (2) A commissioned volunteer enforcement officer may
 5 access the property of a private entity to enforce the
 6 provisions of this section; provided that the private
 7 entity's parking lot contains a parking space required
 8 by section 291-71."

9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
