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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1                                   **PART I.   GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2           SECTION 1.   SHORT TITLE.   This Act shall be known and may  
3 be cited as the Supplemental Improvements Act of 2020.

4           SECTION 2.   This part amends Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii  
5 2019, and other appropriations and authorizations effective  
6 during fiscal biennium 2019-2021.

7           SECTION 3.   Part II of Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019,  
8 is amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:

9           "SECTION 3.   APPROPRIATIONS.   The following sums, or so  
10 much thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and  
11 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or  
12 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing  
13 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal  
14 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.   The  
15 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal  
16 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position



- 1 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
- 2 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.

1 SECTION 4. Part III of Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii  
2 2019, is amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 4. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AUTHORIZED. The  
4 sums appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for  
5 capital improvements shall be expended for the projects listed  
6 below. Accounting of the appropriations by the department of  
7 accounting and general services shall be based on the projects  
8 as the projects are listed in this section. Several related or  
9 similar projects may be combined into a single project if the  
10 combination is advantageous or convenient for implementation;  
11 provided that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall  
12 not exceed the total of the sum specified for the projects  
13 separately. (The amount after each cost element and the total  
14 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of  
15 dollars).

10 any reason, the legislature declares that the remainder of the  
11 Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be  
12 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is  
13 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall  
14 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the  
15 extent possible.

16 SECTION 9. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other  
17 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor is hereby  
18 authorized to correct the errors.


