
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DOMESTIC ABUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 431:10-217.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
3 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:
4 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
5 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
6 injury, or assault between family or household
7 members;
8 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by
9 another;
10 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
11 family or household member; [~~or~~]
12 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
13 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
14 the behavior of another household member[-]; or
15 (5) Emotional abuse, as defined in section 586-1, between
16 family or household members."



1 SECTION 2. Section 432:1-101.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:

4 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
5 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
6 injury, or assault between family or household
7 members;

8 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by
9 another;

10 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
11 family or household member; [~~or~~]

12 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
13 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
14 the behavior of another household member[-]; or

15 (5) Emotional abuse, as defined in section 586-1, between
16 family or household members."

17 SECTION 3. Section 432:2-103.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
18 is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

19 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:

20 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
21 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily

 13 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

14 "(e) As used in this section, "domestic abuse" means:

- 15 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the
- 16 infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily
- 17 injury, or assault between family or household
- 18 members;
- 19 (2) Sexual assault of one family or household member by
- 20 another;



- 1 (3) Stalking of one family or household member by another
- 2 family or household member; [~~o~~]
- 3 (4) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing damage
- 4 to property so as to intimidate or attempt to control
- 5 the behavior of another household member[-]; or
- 6 (5) Emotional abuse, as defined in section 586-1, between
- 7 family or household members."

8 SECTION 5. Section 586-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 9 amended as follows:

10 1. By adding three new definitions to be appropriately
 11 inserted and to read:

12 "Coercive behavior" means a continuing act or a pattern of
 13 acts of assault, threats, humiliation, and intimidation or other
 14 abuse that is used to harm, punish, or frighten a person.

15 "Controlling behavior" means a range of acts designed to
 16 make a person subordinate or dependent by:

- 17 (1) Isolating the person from sources of support;
- 18 (2) Exploiting the person's resources and capacities for
- 19 personal gain;
- 20 (3) Depriving the person of the means needed for
- 21 independence, resistance, and escape; and



1 (4) Regulating the person's everyday behavior.
2 "Emotional abuse" means coercive behavior or controlling
3 behavior that is continuously or repeatedly directed at an
4 individual with the intent to exert power, control, or coercion
5 over the individual."

6 2. By amending the definition of "domestic abuse" to read:

7 "Domestic abuse" means:

8 (1) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the threat
9 of imminent physical harm, bodily injury, or assault,
10 extreme psychological abuse, emotional abuse, or
11 malicious property damage between family or household
12 members; or

13 (2) Any act which would constitute an offense under
14 section 709-906, or under part V or VI of chapter 707
15 committed against a minor family or household member
16 by an adult family or household member."

17 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
