
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish the
3 operating budget for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
4 and ending June 30, 2021, for state executive branch programs
5 under the purview of the house of representatives standing
6 committee on tourism and international affairs.

7 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the
8 context, as used in this Act:

9 "Expending agency" means the department of business,
10 economic development, and tourism.

11 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
12 a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the
13 following:

14 BED Department of business, economic development, and
15 tourism

16 TIA House of representatives standing committee on tourism
17 and international affairs



1 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
2 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
3 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
4 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,
5 shall have the following meanings:

- 6 A General funds
- 7 B Special funds
- 8 N Federal funds
- 9 P Other federal funds

10 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
11 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
12 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
13 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
14 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
15 positions.

16 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
17 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
18 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
19 organization number for the program.

20 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
22 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and



1 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or
2 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing
3 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal
4 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The
5 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal
6 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
7 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
8 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.

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SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the extent possible.

SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may correct the errors.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
