
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUITION WAIVERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2020-2021 to be deposited into the University of Hawaii
6 scholarship and assistance special fund.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the University of
8 Hawaii scholarship and assistance special fund the sum of
9 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for providing scholarships
12 to any qualified student who:

13 (1) Is a spouse or child of a deceased member of the armed
14 forces; and

15 (2) Shall provide specific proof that the applicant would
16 qualify for a gold star lapel button pursuant to the



1 criteria established by title 10 United States Code
2 section 1126.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
