
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUNA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that due to recent lava
2 flows, the only boat ramp and pier in the Puna district on the
3 island of Hawaii is no longer accessible or usable. The purpose
4 of this Act is to appropriate funds for a feasibility and cost
5 study relating to the construction of a new boat ramp and pier
6 in Puna.

7 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources is
8 requested to conduct a feasibility and cost study relating to
9 the construction of a boat ramp in Puna. The department of land
10 and natural resources shall submit a report of its findings and
11 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
12 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
13 the regular session of 2020.

14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for the
17 purposes of this Act.

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
