
A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
STATE OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2 amendment to article II of the Constitution of the State of
3 Hawaii to allow a recount of votes cast at an election to be
4 conducted, as provided by law.

5 SECTION 2. Article II of the Constitution of the State of
6 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
7 designated and to read as follows:

8 "RECOUNT OF ELECTION VOTES

9 Section . A recount of votes cast at an election may be
10 conducted in such manner as shall be provided by law."

11 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
12 be as follows:

13 "Shall the Hawaii State Constitution be amended to allow
14 the Legislature to enact laws that provide for the manner of
15 conducting a recount of votes cast at an election?"

16 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.



1 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect on January 28,
2 2081 and upon compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the
3 Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
