## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,550,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-  
6 ninth representative district, as follows:

7           1. To be expended by the department of education:

8           A. Princess Victoria Kaiulani  
9 elementary school, Oahu.

10           Design and construction for  
11 carpet throughout the school  
12 building.

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
12 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
13 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
14 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
16 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
17 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
