# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:  
4           "§291C-       Display of registration tags or emblems and  
5 inspection stickers. No person shall operate a vehicle  
6 registered and inspected in the State pursuant to chapters 249  
7 and 286 unless the vehicle displays a current, valid  
8 registration tag or emblem that is affixed in the manner  
9 prescribed by section 249-7(c) and a current, valid inspection  
10 sticker that is affixed in the manner prescribed by section 286-  
11 26(e). A law enforcement officer shall issue a citation to any  
12 person who operates a vehicle in violation of this section;  
13 provided that the penalty for a violation of this section shall  
14 be as prescribed in section 286-25 or section 286-61, as  
15 applicable."



# H.B. NO. 788

1           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun before its effective date.

4           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

**Report Title:**

Statewide Traffic Code; Mandatory Citation; Missing Registration Tag or Emblem, or Safety Inspection Sticker
