
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REQUIRE VOTER REGISTRATION
IN THE STATE AND REGISTRATION IN THE UNITED STATES
SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM AS A CONDITION FOR RECEIVING A
PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IN THE STATE.

1 WHEREAS, the promotion of civic education, democratic
2 discourse, and public participation, particularly among young
3 people, is a priority in the State; and
4

5 WHEREAS, in addition to coursework in history and
6 government studies, satisfactory completion of "Participation in
7 Democracy", a course that emphasizes civic discourse and active
8 citizenship, is mandatory for any public school student in the
9 State in order to earn a Hawaii high school diploma; and
10

11 WHEREAS, students in this course examine government
12 structures, political activities, democratic processes, and
13 other contemporary civic issues; and
14

15 WHEREAS, at the federal level, civic participation is
16 encouraged and even required in certain circumstances; and
17

18 WHEREAS, specifically, male United States citizens and male
19 immigrant non-citizens who are not otherwise exempt are required
20 to register with the United States Selective Service System
21 within thirty days of reaching the age of eighteen, and remain
22 registered until the age of twenty-six; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the federal selective service registration
25 requirement ensures a fair and equitable military draft, if ever
26 required, to protect our nation; and
27

28 WHEREAS, registration with the United States Selective
29 Service System is required to qualify for various federal



1 programs and opportunities, including the Free Application for
2 Federal Student Aid, certain student loans, Pell grants, federal
3 employment, federally funded job training, and citizenship
4 through naturalization; and
5

6 WHEREAS, establishing voter registration in the State and
7 registration in the United States Selective Service System as a
8 condition for the issuance of a Hawaii high school diploma to
9 any public high school student in the State promotes the
10 interests and priorities of the State; now, therefore,
11

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
13 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
14 2020, the Senate concurring, that the Board of Education is
15 requested to require voter registration in the State and
16 registration in the United States Selective Service System
17 pursuant to title 50 United States Code chapter 49, as amended,
18 as a condition for receiving a public high school diploma in the
19 State; and
20

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any requirement to register
22 with the federal selective service should not apply to any
23 student who qualifies for the exemption for persons
24 conscientiously opposed to war as specified in title 5 United
25 States Code chapter 49, section 3806, as amended; and
26

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education is
28 requested to adopt administrative rules to effectuate the
29 purposes of this resolution; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
32 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor,
33 Chairperson of the Board of Education, and Superintendent of
34 Education.
