
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, TO IMMEDIATELY AND REGULARLY CLEAN THE DRAINAGE CANALS AND STREAMS IN KANEOHE AND KAILUA AND DEVELOP RECOMMENDED CLEANING SCHEDULES FOR DRAINAGE CANALS AND STREAMS.

1 WHEREAS, between 1915 and 2019, floods have caused more
2 than \$225,000,000 in damage on Oahu; and
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4 WHEREAS, without regular cleaning, human-made and natural
5 debris and sediment can accumulate in drainage canals and
6 streams, creating dams that block the canals and streams; and
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8 WHEREAS, according to the Federal Emergency Management
9 Agency, a blocked drainage canal increases the risk of frequent
10 overbank flooding; and
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12 WHEREAS, according to the Hawaii State Data Book, Kaneohe
13 received 60.61 inches of rainfall in 2017; and
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15 WHEREAS, the lack of regular cleaning of drainage canals
16 and streams in Kaneohe and Kailua increases the risk of flooding
17 in surrounding homes; now, therefore,
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19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
21 2020, that the Department of Facility Maintenance of the City
22 and County of Honolulu, in conjunction with the United States
23 Army Corps of Engineers and Department of Environmental Services
24 of the City and County of Honolulu, is urged to immediately
25 clean the drainage canals and streams in Kaneohe and Kailua; and
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27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Facility
28 Maintenance, in conjunction with the United States Army Corps of



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1 Engineers and Department of Environmental Services of the City
 2 and County of Honolulu, is requested to develop recommended
 3 cleaning schedules for drainage canals and streams and regularly
 4 clean the drainage canals and streams in Kaneohe and Kailua
 5 based on this schedule; and

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 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 8 Resolution be transmitted to the United States Army Corps of
 9 Engineers District Commander of the Honolulu District, Director
 10 of the Department of Environmental Services of the City and
 11 County of Honolulu, and Director and Chief Engineer of the
 12 Department of Facility Maintenance of the City and County of
 13 Honolulu.
