
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO CONSIDER SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET
REQUESTS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER
AFFAIRS.

1 WHEREAS, Act 5, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, and Act 29,
2 Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, established the operating budget
3 for the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs; and
4

5 WHEREAS, a trade-off of \$129,370 in special funds ceiling
6 and one full-time equivalent position is requested to transfer
7 and re-describe one position and special funds ceiling from
8 Cable Television, Program ID CCA102, to the Office of Consumer
9 Protection, Program ID CCA110; and
10

11 WHEREAS, a trust fund ceiling increase of \$497,000 for
12 Cable Television, Program ID CCA102, is requested to offset some
13 of the anticipated financial impacts resulting from the Federal
14 Communications Commission's 2019 Franchise Fees Order with
15 respect to the Institutional Network; and
16

17 WHEREAS, a trust fund ceiling increase of \$400,000 for
18 Cable Television, Program ID CCA102, is requested to expand
19 broadband access by partnering with the Hawaii State Public
20 Library System to establish a Mobile WiFi Hotspot Lending Pilot
21 Program; and

23 WHEREAS, an increase of \$50,000 in special funds for
24 Financial Services Regulation, Program ID CCA104, is requested
25 for the purchase of a recurring subscription for a document
26 management system to manage and store documents; and

28 WHEREAS, a trust fund ceiling increase of \$49,000 in
29 Insurance Regulatory Services, Program ID CCA106, is requested
30 to attend more training and conduct increased community outreach
31 programs; and

 2 WHEREAS, a trade-off of \$141,485 in special funds ceiling
 3 and one full-time equivalent position is requested to transfer
 4 and re-describe one position from Insurance Regulatory Services,
 5 Program ID CCA106, to the Office of Consumer Protection, Program
 6 ID CCA110; and

7
 8 WHEREAS, a trade-off of \$54,432 in special funds ceiling
 9 and one full-time equivalent position is requested to transfer
 10 and re-describe one position from Insurance Regulatory Services,
 11 Program ID CCA106, to General Support, Program ID CCA191; and

12
 13 WHEREAS, the transfer of positions is considered the
 14 highest priority for the Department of Commerce and Consumer
 15 Affairs; and

16
 17 WHEREAS, these adjustments to the Department of Commerce
 18 and Consumer Affairs' existing budget are requested to reflect
 19 shifts in programmatic needs and priorities; now, therefore,

 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 22 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of
 23 2020, that the Legislature is requested to consider the
 24 supplemental budget requests of the Department of Commerce and
 25 Consumer Affairs; and

 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
 28 Resolution be transmitted to the Chair of the House Standing
 29 Committee on Finance.
