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## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO EXPLORE THE  
FEASIBILITY OF NEGOTIATING THE TRANSFER OF LAND PARCEL  
81002087000 FOR THE FUTURE EXPANSION OF KE KULA 'O  
'EHUNUIKAIMALINO CHARTER SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, Ke Kula 'o 'Ehunuikaimalino is a Hawaiian immersion  
2 public charter-school located in Kealakekua on the island of  
3 Hawaii; and  
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5 WHEREAS, Ke Kula 'o 'Ehunuikaimalino is part of the Hawai'i  
6 District Honoka'a Kealakehe Kohala Konawaena Complex Area; and  
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8 WHEREAS, the staff and families of Ke Kula 'o  
9 'Ehunuikaimalino are committed to perpetuating the language,  
10 customs, traditions, skills, spirituality, and character of the  
11 Hawaiian people; and  
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13 WHEREAS, Ke Kula 'o 'Ehunuikaimalino has the need to expand  
14 its facilities in the near future to better serve its student  
15 body ranging from pre-kindergarten to twelfth grade; and  
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17 WHEREAS, the Complex Area Superintendent can provide  
18 support in conjunction with the necessary state agencies to  
19 oversee the land transfer and provide a report to the  
20 Legislature on steps moving forward for the land transfer to be  
21 complete; and  
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23 WHEREAS, the land parcel identified as 81002087000 is  
24 adjacent to Ke Kula 'o 'Ehunuikaimalino's existing campus; now,  
25 therefore,  
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27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
28 Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of  
29 2020, that the:

- 31 (1) Department of Education is requested to explore the  
32 feasibility of negotiating the transfer of land parcel

 2 school for that school's future expansion; and  
 3  
 4 (2) Complex Area Superintendent of the Hawai'i District  
 5 Honoka'a Kealakehe Kohala Konawaena Complex Area report  
 6 back to the Legislature by July 1, 2020; and  
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8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Complex Area Superintendent  
 9 of the Hawai'i District Honoka'a Kealakehe Kohala Konawaena  
 10 Complex Area shall initiate consultations with the necessary  
 11 state agencies immediately upon the Department of Education  
 12 receiving a copy of this resolution and is requested to file an  
 13 initial report with the legislature by no later than June 1,  
 14 2020, which sets forth the plan for effecting the land transfer,  
 15 the state departments that are assisting to effect the land  
 16 transfer, and any identified circumstances that could delay the  
 17 land transfer. Thereafter, the Complex Area Superintendent is  
 18 requested to file monthly status updates on progress made toward  
 19 effecting the land transfer; provided that, by no later than  
 20 twenty days prior to the opening of the 2021 legislative  
 21 session, the Complex Area Superintendent is requested to file  
 22 with the Legislature a comprehensive report detailing the  
 23 current status of the land transfer, the progress made towards  
 24 effecting the land transfer, and if the land transfer has not  
 25 been effected as of that date, the specific reasons why it has  
 26 not yet been effected; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
 29 Resolution be transmitted to the Chair of the Board of  
 30 Education, Superintendent of Education, Executive Director of  
 31 the State Public Charter School Commission, and Chair of the  
 32 School Community Council and Principal of Ke Kula 'o  
 33 'Ehunuikaimalino charter school.
