RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

5 may be necessary, to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 all

7 with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective
8 bargaining unit (4):

 20 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds




1 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,

3 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
4 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2020, and
5 June 30, 2021, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
6 those dates.
