A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$35,863,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the ninth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Aina Haina elementary school
8 Plans, design, and construction for
9 parking lot paving, striping,
10 landscaping, and fencing.

13 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations
17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
