
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FELONIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1112, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~{}~~§711-1112~~{}~~ Interference with the operator or
4 operation of a public transit vehicle. (1) A person commits
5 the offense of interference with the operator or operation of a
6 public transit vehicle if the person interferes with the
7 operation of a public transit vehicle or lessens the ability of
8 the operator to operate the public transit vehicle by:

9 (a) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing bodily
10 injury to the operator of the public transit vehicle~~{~~
11 ~~or~~ ;

12 (b) Threatening, by word or conduct, to cause bodily
13 injury to the operator of the public transit vehicle
14 with the intent to terrorize, or in reckless disregard
15 of the risk of terrorizing the operator of the public
16 transit vehicle~~{~~ ; or



1 (c) Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing the
2 malfunction or breakdown of operation of a public
3 transit vehicle, system, or service that results in
4 serious bodily injury to or death of any person.

5 (2) For the purposes of this section, "public transit
6 vehicle" is [a]:

7 (a) A public paratransit vehicle providing service to the
8 disabled[~~any~~];

9 (b) Any transit vehicle used for the transportation of
10 passengers in return for legally charged fees or
11 fares[~~any~~];

12 (c) Any transit vehicle owned or operated by a government
13 entity;

14 (d) Any school bus[~~or any~~]; or

15 (e) Any taxi.

16 (3) Interference with the operator or operation of a
17 public transit vehicle is a class C felony."

18 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
