3 The governor may grant reprieves, commutations and pardons,
4 after conviction, for all offenses, subject to [~~regulation~~]
5 procedures and regulations prescribed by law [~~as to the manner~~
6 ~~of applying for the same~~]. The legislature may, by [~~general~~]
7 law, authorize the governor to grant pardons before conviction,
8 to grant pardons for impeachment and to restore civil rights
9 denied by reason of conviction of offenses by tribunals other
10 than those of this State.

11 The governor shall appoint an administrative director to
12 serve at the governor's pleasure."

13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
14 be as follows:

15 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended
16 to provide that the Governor's pardon power shall be
17 subject to procedures and regulations prescribed by law?"

18 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
19 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
20 underscored.



1 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
2 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
3 the State of Hawaii.
