A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) A person may be granted a provisional license to
4 drive passenger cars of any gross vehicle weight rating, buses
5 designed to transport fifteen or fewer occupants, and trucks and
6 vans having a gross vehicle weight rating of [~~fifteen~~] eighteen
7 thousand pounds or less if the person:
- 8 (1) Is at least sixteen years of age but under the age of
9 eighteen;
- 10 (2) Holds an instruction permit and has held the permit
11 for a period of at least one hundred eighty days and
12 there is no pending proceeding that might result in
13 the suspension or revocation of the instruction
14 permit; and
- 15 (3) Satisfactorily completes all requirements of sections
16 286-108 and 286-109."
