A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§107- State buildings; energy efficiency. (a) The
5 comptroller shall cause any state building with air conditioning
6 to set the operating temperature at no less than seventy-three
7 degrees Fahrenheit.

8 (b) This section shall not apply to the following:


- 9 (1) Storage facilities or units that require different
10 temperatures for proper storage purposes;
11 (2) Scientific purposes; and
12 (3) Medical purposes."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
