A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section,
4 every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the
5 employer, wages at the rate of not less than:
6 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003;
7 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006;
8 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007;
9 (4) \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015;
10 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016;
11 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; [~~and~~]
12 (7) \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018 [~~-~~];
13 (8) \$11.30 per hour beginning January 1, 2021;
14 (9) \$12.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2022;
15 (10) \$13.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2023; and
16 (11) \$15.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024."
