A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "51- Mass transit; fares for senior citizens and
5 students. A county providing a mass transit service pursuant to
6 this chapter shall not collect more than thirty-five dollars for
7 the purchase of an annual mass transit pass from:

8 (1) A senior citizen, defined as any person sixty-five
9 years of age or older; or

10 (2) A youth, defined as any person six through seventeen
11 years of age or any person eighteen or nineteen years
12 of age with a valid high school identification card.

13 For purposes of this section, an "annual mass transit pass"
14 means a card, ticket, or similar document distributed as
15 approved by the mass transit service operator that entitles the
16 holder to unlimited rides on the mass transit service for a one-
17 year period."




