
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Education research and development revolving
5 fund; established. There is established in the department an
6 education research and development revolving fund into which
7 shall be deposited all revenues from the commercial adoption of
8 products and services developed by the department. Funds
9 deposited into this revolving fund may be expended by the
10 department to support the research and development of innovative
11 curriculum, instructional materials, and related technologies."

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
15 deposit into the education research and development revolving
16 fund.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 education for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the education
4 research and development revolving fund the sum of \$
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
6 to support the research and development of innovative
7 curriculum, instructional materials, and related technologies.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 education for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
