# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 206M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "PART . HAWAII BROADBAND OFFICE
- 5 §206M- Definitions. As used in this part:
- 6 "Broadband" means high-speed internet access that is always
- 7 on, including mobile and fixed technologies.
- 8 "Corporation" means the Hawaii technology development
- 9 corporation.
- 10 "Office" means the Hawaii broadband office.
- 11 §206M- Hawaii broadband office; establishment; state
- 12 broadband strategy officer; staff. (a) There is established
- 13 the Hawaii broadband office within the Hawaii technology
- 14 development corporation.
- 15 (b) The chief executive officer of the Hawaii technology
- 16 development corporation shall appoint, exempt from chapter 76, a
- 17 state broadband strategy officer to head the office. The

- 1 corporation shall employ any staff as may be necessary for the
  2 purposes of this part; provided that any staff employed pursuant
- 3 to this section shall be exempt from chapter 76.
- 4 §206M- Hawaii broadband office; duties. In furtherance
- 5 of the State's objectives and policies for the economy pursuant
- 6 to section 226-10.5, the office shall:
- 7 (1) Develop and implement specific strategies and plans to
- 8 aggressively increase broadband affordability,
- 9 penetration, and competitive availability in the
- 10 State;
- 11 (2) Support the efforts of both public and private
- 12 entities in Hawaii to enhance or facilitate the
- deployment of and access to competitively priced,
- 14 advanced electronic communications services, including
- 15 broadband and its products and services and internet
- 16 access services of general application throughout
- 17 Hawaii;
- 18 (3) Promote the landing of trans-Pacific submarine cable,
- including the development of a shared access cable
- 20 station and associated terrestrial connectivity to
- 21 reduce barriers to fiber landing in Hawaii;

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1	(4)	Promote, advocate, and facilitate the implementation
2		of the findings and recommendations of the Hawaii
3		broadband task force established by Act 2, First
4		Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2007; and
5	(5)	Actively seek out funding from private and public
6		sources in furtherance of the office's duties pursuant
7		to this part.
8	§206	M- Broadband planning and coordination; cooperation.
9	(a) The	office shall:
10	(1)	Seek input and the widest possible cooperation from
11		public and private agencies and individuals to achieve
12		the purposes of this part;
13	(2)	Promote coordinated broadband planning; and
14	(3)	To the extent feasible, incorporate the ideas and
15		suggestions of broadband stakeholders in the office's
16		planning directives.
17	(b)	Nothing in this part shall be construed to delegate or
18	detract i	n any way from the functions, powers, and duties
19	conferred	by law or rule on any department or agency of the
20	State or	county."

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- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 4 the creation and staffing of the Hawaii broadband office,
- 5 including the establishment of three full-time equivalent (3.00
- 6 FTE) positions that are exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised
- 7 Statutes.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 9 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
