# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. There are established within the department of  
2 public safety twenty-three full-time equivalent (23.00 FTE)  
3 permanent staff positions for the women's community correctional  
4 center hookipa makai cottage (PSD409/EK).

5           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,424,678 or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the  
8 women's community correctional center hookipa makai cottage  
9 (PSD409/EK).

10           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
11 public safety for the purposes of this Act.

12           SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,285,307 or so much  
14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to finance  
15 six additional months of housing costs, from July 1, 2019, to  
16 December 31, 2019, for two hundred forty-eight inmates sent to



1 Saguaro Correctional Center in Arizona and to finance costs to  
2 return the inmates to Hawaii (PSD808/EM).

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
4 public safety for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
