A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOBACCO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§302A-102 [~~Smoking~~] Tobacco use prohibited. (a) All
4 public schools within the State, from kindergarten through grade
5 twelve, shall prohibit the use of tobacco at public schools or
6 at public school functions.

7 (b) Any person under the age of eighteen who uses tobacco
8 at a public school or public school function shall be required
9 to attend a tobacco education course, accompanied by the
10 person's parent or guardian. The parent or guardian shall pay
11 \$25 to offset the cost of the course, which may include the
12 costs of an instructor, materials, and facility.

13 (c) Any person eighteen years and older but under twenty-
14 one years of age who uses tobacco at a public school or public
15 school function shall be required to attend a tobacco education
16 course and pay \$25 to offset the cost of the course, which may
17 include the costs of an instructor, materials, and facility.

Smoking; Public Schools; Tobacco Education Course; Fee

Description:

Establishes a requirement that persons under 21 years of age who use tobacco at a public school or public school function attend a tobacco education course. Persons under 18 years of age shall be accompanied to the course by their parent or guardian. Establishes a related fee.
