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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WASTE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 514B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§514B- Waste cooking oil receptacles. The association  
5 of any high-rise property shall provide at least one waste  
6 cooking oil receptacle in an easily accessible location on the  
7 property to allow residents to deposit grease and waste cooking  
8 oil. The contents of the receptacle shall be collected and  
9 disposed of through a waste hauler permitted by the county in  
10 which the property is located.


11           For purposes of this section, "high-rise property" means  
12 any property consisting of seven stories or more."

13           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
