
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE STADIUM
AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 SECTION 2. Act 5, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, section 3,
5 appropriated \$9,297,877 in special funds to the department of
6 accounting and general services to fund payroll and operating
7 costs for the stadium authority.

8 To ensure and maintain a safe facility for the general
9 public and to ensure operating efficiencies, the stadium
10 authority determined that various unbudgeted expenses would need
11 to be addressed.

12 Funding to address an annual structural assessment report
13 (from biennial to annual), project-design costs to initiate
14 repair and maintenance based on annual structural assessment
15 report(s), contracts to ensure law enforcement presence at
16 events, various expenses related to safe operating equipment,



1 FCC frequency compliant wireless microphones, perimeter wall
2 padding, and various other items are urgently needed.

3 The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
4 appropriation to provide funds for the stadium authority to
5 address the foregoing items.

6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the stadium
7 special fund the sum of \$1,137,708 or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for to address the foregoing
9 costs for the stadium authority.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the stadium
11 authority for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
