
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PAYMENT FOR AIRPORT CHARGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 261-7.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+] §261-7.6~~ ~~[+]~~ Use of credit cards, debit cards, and
4 online electronic payment systems to pay for airport charges.

5 (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any payments
6 due and owing to the State for any products or services received
7 from the State at any ~~[airport]~~ airports operated by the State
8 may be made by an online electronic payment system or credit or
9 debit card, if prior arrangements have been made by the
10 department for payments through the use of the online electronic
11 payment system or credit or debit card and the arrangements have
12 been approved by the comptroller; provided that online
13 electronic payment systems and credit and debit cards may not be
14 used to make payments under protest pursuant to section 40-35.
15 The maximum charge that may be paid to the department by use of
16 an online electronic payment system or a credit or debit card on
17 any transaction is \$500.



1 (b) Processing fees or charges may be paid to the online
2 electronic payment system or credit or debit card processor by
3 an airport for the use of an online electronic payment system or
4 credit or debit card service; provided that the airport shall
5 impose additional processing fees or charges upon the user for
6 the online electronic or credit or debit card payment, the
7 amount of which shall not exceed the amount of the processing
8 fees or charges imposed on the airport for the subject
9 transaction; provided further that the airport may require that
10 the purchaser pay the processing fees or charges directly to the
11 processor."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
