12 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
18 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
19 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

20 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (9) shall
21 be expended by the department of education;



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- 1 (2) The sum appropriated in item (10) shall be expended by
2 the department of accounting and general services; and
3 (3) The sum appropriated in item (11) shall be expended by
4 the department of land and natural resources.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
