# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTIONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:



3           "(b) All other vehicles, including motorcycles, mopeds,  
4 trailers, semitrailers, and pole trailers having a gross vehicle  
5 weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less, and antique motor  
6 vehicles as defined in section 249-1, except those in  
7 subsections (c) and (d), shall be certified as provided in  
8 subsection (e) every [~~twelve~~] twenty-four months; provided that  
9 any vehicle to which this subsection applies, except a moped,  
10 shall not require inspection within [~~two~~] three years of the  
11 date on which the vehicle was first sold."

12           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
