A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$14,890,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the eleventh
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. President Theodore Roosevelt High
8 School

9 A. Plans, design, construction, and
10 equipment for new music facilities
11 with classrooms, practice rooms,
12 teacher offices, and other related
13 facilities; ground and site
14 improvements; equipment and
15 appurtenances.

2 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
3 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
5 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
6 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

7 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
8 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
9 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this
10 Act.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
