A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-429, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) A candidate shall obtain the minimum qualifying
4 contribution amount set forth in subsection (a) once for the
5 election period.

6 (1) If the candidate obtains the minimum qualifying
7 contribution amount, the candidate is eligible to
8 receive:

9 (A) The minimum payment in an amount equal to the
10 minimum qualifying contribution amounts; ~~and~~

11 (B) Payments of \$1 for each \$1 of qualifying
12 contributions in excess of the minimum qualifying
13 contribution amounts; and

14 (C) Payments of \$3 for each \$1 of qualifying
15 contributions of \$5 or less in excess of minimum
16 qualifying contribution amounts; and

1 (2) A candidate shall have at least one other qualified
2 candidate as an opponent for the primary or general
3 election to receive public funds for that election."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
