# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,  
AND TOURISM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this part is to establish the  
3 operating budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and  
4 ending June 30, 2021, for state executive branch programs under  
5 the purview of the house of representatives standing committee  
6 on economic development and business.

7 SECTION 2. Unless otherwise clear from the context, as  
8 used in this part:

9 "Expending agency" means the executive department,  
10 independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other  
11 establishment of the state government (other than the  
12 legislature, office of Hawaiian affairs, and judiciary), the  
13 political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public  
14 institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which  
15 is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this  
16 part.



1 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or  
2 a standing committee of the house of representatives, shall mean  
3 the following:

4 BED department of business, economic development, and  
5 tourism

6 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which  
7 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the  
8 programs and projects specified in this part. All  
9 appropriations are followed by letter symbols. The letter  
10 symbols, where used, shall have the following meanings:

11 A General funds

12 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent  
13 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a  
14 particular program during a specified period or periods, as  
15 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent  
16 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent  
17 positions.

18 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific  
19 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization  
20 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the  
21 organization number for the program.



1 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may  
2 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated  
3 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may  
4 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending  
5 agencies designated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020,  
6 and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the number  
7 of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall not  
8 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each  
9 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this part or as  
10 provided by general law.

PART II

SECTION 4. Section 201-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

**"§201-113 Hawaii film and creative industries development special fund.** (a) There is established in the state treasury the Hawaii film and creative industries development special fund into which shall be deposited:

- (1) Appropriations by the legislature;
- (2) Donations and contributions made by private individuals or organizations for deposit into the fund;
- (3) Grants provided by governmental agencies or any other source; and
- (4) Effective January 2, 2021, all revenues, fees, and charges from the processing of the motion picture, digital media, and film production income tax credit pursuant to section 235-17.

(b) The fund shall be used by the [~~(A) The grant shall be used exclusively for eligible Hawaii projects;~~] department to provide for:



- 1 (1) A program to provide seed capital for film, media, and
- 2 creative industries intellectual property development
- 3 projects for export, as determined by the department;
- 4 (2) Programs that expand the skills of the State's resident
- 5 workforce in the film, media, and creative industries;
- 6 and
- 7 (3) Marketing programs that attract business opportunities
- 8 within the film, media, and creative industries in the
- 9 State."

10 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii film  
 11 and creative industries development special fund the sum of  
 12 \$450,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
 13 2020-2021 for the purposes of this fund to fulfill the match for  
 14 federal grants for fiscal year 2021.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 16 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of  
 17 this Act.

18 PART III

19 SECTION 6. If any portion of this Act or its application  
 20 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for  
 21 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of



1 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be  
2 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is  
3 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall  
4 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the  
5 extent possible.

6 SECTION 7. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other  
7 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may  
8 correct the errors.

9 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
10 and stricken.

11 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
