A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$37,224,820 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 twenty-fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kailua Public Library, Oahu

2 the State of Hawaii for fiscal year 2020-2021.

8 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital
9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
11 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
12 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 4. (a) The sums appropriated for the respective
14 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for
15 the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 16 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (9) shall
17 be expended by the department of education;
- 18 (2) The sum appropriated in item (10) shall be expended by
19 the department of accounting and general services;
- 20 (3) The sums appropriated in item (11) shall be expended
21 by the department of health; and



1 (4) The sums appropriated in item (12) shall be expended
2 by the University of Hawaii.

3 (b) The sum appropriated for the capital project set forth
4 in section 2 shall be expended for the purposes of this Act by
5 the department of land and natural resources.

6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
