# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 26-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:  
3           "**§26-31 Selection and terms of single executives as heads**  
4 **of departments[-]; selection of deputy directors of departments.**  
5 (a) Except as otherwise provided by the Constitution of the  
6 State or by this chapter, each principal department shall be  
7 headed by a single executive, who shall be nominated and, by and  
8 with the advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the  
9 governor, for a term to expire at the end of the term for which  
10 the governor was elected. A vacancy occurring during a term  
11 shall be filled for the unexpired balance of the term, subject  
12 to the provisions of Article V, section 6 of the Constitution of  
13 the State. The governor may remove a single executive from  
14 office at any time, except that the removal of the attorney  
15 general shall be subject to the advice and consent of the  
16 senate.

1        (b) Except as otherwise provided by the Constitution of  
 2 the State or by this chapter, the deputy director and deputy  
 3 chair of each principal department shall be nominated and, by  
 4 and with the advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the  
 5 governor, single executive of a principal department, or the  
 6 chair of the board, commission, or other body."

7        SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
