A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWELFTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$35,773,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twelfth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Ala Wai elementary school

8 A. Covered playcourt.

9 Construction \$1,000,000

11 2. Lunalilo elementary school

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
12 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
13 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
14 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
17 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for
18 the purposes of this Act as follows:

19 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 4 shall be
20 expended by the department of education; and




