A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[~~§~~§10-10~~]~~ Administrator; appointment, tenure, removal.
4 The board by a majority vote, shall appoint an administrator who
5 shall serve without regard to the provisions of chapter 76 for a
6 term to be determined by the board. The board, by [~~a two-~~
7 ~~thirds~~] majority vote [~~of all members to which it is entitled~~],
8 may remove the administrator [~~for cause~~] at any time."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
