# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SECURITY PERSONNEL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 463-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) All guards, and all agents, operatives, and  
4 assistants employed by a guard agency, private business entity,  
5 or government agency who act in a guard capacity shall apply to  
6 register with the board, and meet the following registration,  
7 instruction, and training requirements prior to acting as a  
8 guard:

9 (1) Be not less than eighteen years of age;

10 (2) Possess a high school education or its equivalent;  
11 provided that the applicant may satisfy the  
12 requirements of this paragraph by attesting that the  
13 applicant possesses a high school education or its  
14 equivalent;

15 (3) Not be presently suffering from any psychiatric or  
16 psychological disorder which is directly related and



1           detrimental to a person's performance in the  
2           profession; and  
3           (4) Not have been convicted in any jurisdiction of a crime  
4           which reflects unfavorably on the fitness of the  
5           individual to act as a guard, unless the conviction  
6           has been annulled or expunged by court order; provided  
7           that the individual shall submit to a national  
8           criminal history record check as authorized by federal  
9           law, including but not limited to the Private Security  
10          Officer Employment Authorization Act of 2004, and  
11          specified in the rules of the board, and a criminal  
12          history record check from the Hawaii criminal justice  
13          data center under chapter 846.

14 The board shall determine whether an individual qualifies for  
15 registration pursuant to this subsection.

16          For purposes of this subsection the term "guard" does not  
17 include any person directly employed as security personnel by  
18 the department of education or the University of Hawaii pursuant  
19 to chapters 76 and 78; provided that the department of education  
20 or the University of Hawaii may hire security personnel  
21 applicants who do not possess a guard card pursuant to this



1 subsection at the beginning of their employment; provided  
2 further that applicants hired without a guard card shall obtain  
3 one after being employed for one year as security personnel."

4 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
