
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IMPROVEMENTS AT WAIPAHU HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$20,575,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020
5 for the purpose of capital improvements projects at Waipahu high
6 school, as follows:

2 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
3 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
5 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
6 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.
7 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the capital projects
8 set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the department of
9 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
