A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 89-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) For the purpose of negotiating a collective
4 bargaining agreement, the public employer of an appropriate
5 bargaining unit shall mean the governor together with the
6 director of finance, and the following employers:

7 (1) For bargaining units (1), (2), (3), (4), (9), (10),
8 (13), and (14), the governor shall have six votes, the
9 director of finance shall have one vote, and the
10 mayors, the chief justice, and the Hawaii health
11 systems corporation board shall each have one vote if
12 they have employees in the particular bargaining unit;

13 (2) For bargaining units (11) and (12), the governor shall
14 have four votes, the director of finance shall have
15 one vote, and the mayors shall each have one vote;

16 (3) For bargaining units (5) and (6), the governor shall
17 have three votes, the director of finance shall have
