# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$35,420,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-  
6 fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Ahuimanu Elementary School

8 Design and construction for ADA  
9 accessibility routes to connect lower  
10 and upper campuses.

11 Design \$80,000

12 Construction \$220,000

13 Total funding \$300,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 2. Ben Parker Elementary School

# S.B. NO. 709

1           SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
5 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

6           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
