A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 346D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Waiver programs shall be established and administered
4 by the department of human services to provide comprehensive
5 home and community-based services for [the]:

6 (1) The aged, chronically ill, disabled, developmentally
7 disabled, and individuals with intellectual
8 disabilities[7]; and

9 (2) Individuals who:

10 (A) Require home care services more than twice
11 weekly;

12 (B) Do not have ready access to reliable
13 transportation; and

14 (C) Live thirty miles or more from the nearest
15 hospital;

1 who are certified as requiring acute, skilled nursing,
2 intermediate care facility, or intermediate care facility for

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Health care; Medicaid; Comprehensive Home and Community-Based Services

Description:

Allows individuals who require home care services more than twice weekly, do not have ready access to reliable transportation, and live thirty miles or more from the nearest hospital, to be eligible for medicaid home and community-based services that are administered by the department of human services.

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
