# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify that any  
2 seller of goods that offers free or reduced shipping to a  
3 purchaser in any other state in the United States but who  
4 discriminates against Hawaii residents by refusing to honor that  
5 free or reduced shipping offer for items shipped to Hawaii has  
6 engaged in an act that is unfair and deceptive as to Hawaii  
7 consumers.

8           SECTION 2. Section 481A-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10           " ~~[+]~~ §481A-3 ~~[+]~~ Deceptive trade practices. (a) A person  
11 engages in a deceptive trade practice when, in the course of the  
12 person's business, vocation, or occupation, the person:

- 13           (1) Passes off goods or services as those of another;
- 14           (2) Causes likelihood of confusion or of misunderstanding  
15           as to the source, sponsorship, approval, or  
16           certification of goods or services;



- 1           (3) Causes likelihood of confusion or of misunderstanding  
2           as to affiliation, connection, or association with, or  
3           certification by, another;
- 4           (4) Uses deceptive representations or designations of  
5           geographic origin in connection with goods or  
6           services;
- 7           (5) Represents that goods or services have sponsorship,  
8           approval, characteristics, ingredients, uses,  
9           benefits, or quantities that they do not have or that  
10          a person has a sponsorship, approval, status,  
11          affiliation, or connection that the person does not  
12          have;
- 13          (6) Represents that goods are original or new if they are  
14          deteriorated, altered, reconditioned, reclaimed, used,  
15          or secondhand;
- 16          (7) Represents that goods or services are of a particular  
17          standard, quality, or grade, or that goods are of a  
18          particular style or model, if they are of another;
- 19          (8) Disparages the goods, services, or business of another  
20          by false or misleading representation of fact;



1 (9) Advertises goods or services with intent not to sell  
2 them as advertised;

3 (10) Advertises goods or services with intent not to supply  
4 reasonably expectable public demand, unless the  
5 advertisement discloses a limitation of quantity;

6 (11) Makes false or misleading statements of fact  
7 concerning the reasons for, existence of, or amounts  
8 of price reductions; [øx]

9 (12) Refuses to honor free or reduced rate shipping to a  
10 consumer in this State that is marketed or advertised  
11 to consumers in another state. This paragraph shall  
12 not apply to goods whose shipping is deemed hazardous  
13 or restricted as defined by the United States Postal  
14 Service; or

15 [~~12~~] (13) Engages in any other conduct which similarly  
16 creates a likelihood of confusion or of  
17 misunderstanding.

18 (b) In order to prevail in an action under this chapter, a  
19 complainant need not prove competition between the parties or  
20 actual confusion or misunderstanding.

1 (c) This section does not affect unfair trade practices  
 2 otherwise actionable at common law or under other statutes of  
 3 this State.

4 (d) Any consumer, class of consumers, or de facto class of  
 5 consumers who is or are injured by any act or practice forbidden  
 6 or declared unlawful under this section shall be entitled to the  
 7 remedies set forth under 480-13."

8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

**Report Title:**

Deceptive Trade Practices; Free or Reduced Rate Shipping
