A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The University of Hawai'i shall establish
2 an annual free application day in which all application fees for
3 applications to any campus of the University of Hawai'i system
4 shall be waived for prospective students who qualify for Hawai'i
5 resident tuition.

6 (b) At least sixty days prior to the date of the free
7 application day, the University of Hawai'i shall issue public
8 notice of the date of the free application day in a statewide
9 publication, or any other appropriate means, including but not
10 limited to the Internet.

11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
