# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The university of Hawaii shall establish a  
2 two-year free application day pilot project for students  
3 applying for admission for the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 academic  
4 years. During the application period for each of the academic  
5 years, the university of Hawaii shall designate a date on which  
6 all application fees for applications to any campus of the  
7 university of Hawaii system shall be waived for prospective  
8 students who qualify for Hawaii resident tuition.

9           (b) The university of Hawaii shall provide public notice  
10 of the date of the free application day at least sixty days in  
11 advance via a statewide publication, or any other appropriate  
12 means, including but not limited to the internet.

13           SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
